

TYPICAL SPECIFICATIONS

Electric countertop hot dog steamers shall have a stainless steel body and interior and be equipped with a thermostatic control and metal sheath heating element. Model No. 8300 shall be equipped with a low water indicator light (not included on the Model No. 8301). The unit shall have tempered sliding glass doors and merchandising glass at rear of unit. The unit shall have a maximum heat setting of 200°F. 120V unit shall have a 6' cord and NEMA 5-15p plug; 220V unit shall have a 6' cord and NEMA 6-15p plug, 230V unit shall have a 6' cord and SCHUKO CEE-7-7 plug. Electric hot dog steamers carry the approval of ETL and shall be listed with the National Sanitation Foundation.
